- 1. Please label the Airlie Road Public ROW with the width of the ROW at the intersection of the access road.
- 2. Please label the 20' Access Road with a street name and designate it as Public or Private Road.
- 3. The 20' Access Easement appears to be using the Alley cross section. Please show the City of Wilmington Standard Detail for an Alley on the site plan. Extend the stone base beyond the header curb for support, per the SD. [SD 3-01.9, CofW Tech Stds]

## TECHNICAL STANDARDS – ACCESS (driveway, sidewalk, and sight distance):

- 4. Proposed site plan fronts Airlie Road, a public ROW, however, a Sidewalk has not been shown along the ROW. Please show sidewalk.
- 5. Show the Sidewalk Detail on the site plan. [SD 3-10, CofWTSSM].

## **TECHNICAL STANDARDS – PARKING:**

- 6. Provide a turning movement analysis of a Fire Engine and Rescue vehicle at turnarounds at Lot #2 and Lot # 4 locations.
- 7. Although not a requirement, it is requested the Applicant consider adding some bicycle parking.
