Engineering has reviewed the plans for the NHRMC Orthopedic Inpatient Hospital project submitted June 20, 2017 and have the following comments:

- 1. Application: Section II.1. The project is a permit modification of an existing high-density permit. It is not a drainage plan as checked on the application. I can make the correction, if so authorized. Also, the review fee submitted is for a drainage plan (\$200) instead of a permit modification (\$500). The check has not been deposited yet. I need an additional \$300. Would you like me to return the check and N&T submit a new \$500 check or do you wish to submit another \$300 check? Please advise.
- 2. Storm Sewer Tabulation: Check lines 33 and 34. The calcs list a 24 and 18 inch pipes but the plans show 12 and a 24 inch pipes. Table on C2R shows the same.
- 3. Can you provide a description of what tailwater condition was assigned?
- 4. HydroCAD Routing: Rerun the routing using a Type III storm for the 1.5" and the 10-year. 6.72" is the depth that can be used instead of 7.00 if that helps show that the 10-year is infiltrated.
- 5. A minimum of one observation well shall be provided at the low point in the system unless the subgrade is terraced; in that case, there shall be one well for each terrace.
