- 1. The Landscape plans do not have the same street names as the site plans. Sandalwood Way and Old Towne is mentioned on the landscape plans. Site plans show Old Towne Street and Harpswell Plaza. Please revise.
- 2. Please show the name of Water Craft Ferry Extension on the landscape plans.

TECHNICAL STANDARDS – ACCESS (driveway, sidewalk, and sight distance):

- 3. The location of the Pedestrian crossing signs were not clear on the site plans. Please revise.
- 4. The landscaping plans shows many street trees and on site trees that are located within the 46' X46' Sight Distance Triangles for intersections of Harpswell Plaza and Water Craft Ferry Avenue. Please revise.
- 5. The intersection of Old Towne Street and Water Craft Ferry Street show street trees in bold font and in shaded font. The trees in shaded font, which are closest to the intersection, appear to be located in the 46' X46' Sight Distance Triangles.

TECHNICAL STANDARDS – PARKING:

6. The minimum radius request is typically granted when Auto Turns demonstrate good circulation. A formal variance letter will not be required.[Chapter VII, Detail SD 15-13 CofWTSSM]
