NCDOT:

• Show the proposed new ROW for the Military Cutoff Widening along the frontage for this site and driveway location.

TECHNICAL STANDARDS – ACCESS (driveway, sidewalk, and sight distance):

- 1. The site plans show a 36' wide driveway. Pavement markings must be installed for driveways 36' or greater. Please revise.
- 2. Please show the angle of the existing driveway. Driveways are to intersect the street at a 90 degree angle. [7-11 #3 CofW Tech Stds]

TECHNICAL STANDARDS – PARKING:

3. The parking lots have a minimum of 24' wide drive aisle, and support two way traffic. Please modify the parking arrows to show two way travel within the parking lot.

MISCELLANEOUS:

Transportation Planning Staff will review the landscape plan once submitted for compliance with sight distance requirements.
