#### TECHNICAL STANDARDS – ACCESS (driveway, sidewalk, and sight distance):

- 1. The proposed sidewalk connections must connect to the proposed lots. The connections shown appear to end within the common areas.
- 2. Please coordinate with City Engineering to provide a detail for the proposed 10' Multi-Use Trail.
- 3. Provide a Standard Detail SD 3-10 for the sidewalk. [Detail, SD 3-10, CofW Tech Stds]
