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Engineering has reviewed the plans for The Marshes 3, 4 and 5 project submitted June 11, 2020 and have the following comments:

1. Please verify that all existing utilities, guy wires, etc. have been located and shown on the plan near the intersection of Independence and River Road in order to avoid conflicts with the proposed swale and 12" pipe w/FES.


### Comments on Sheet 5 of 9


- 2. With your recommended coordination with CFPUA adjacent project, have you seen any plans? This will affect the "DIP" repair scope in the pavement
- 3. Plans say, "Level Dip in Ex. Pavement" up near the bridge. Adding more pavement to settling pavement is not a satisfactory solution. Would recommend having Geotech look at this area and recommend a more permanent fix. Possibly remove, stabilize subgrade, and replace pavement as needed here.
- 4. If no work is happening around Guardrail you may retain it. But I do not feel like that is the case here. Since we are performing work in and around the existing guardrail, the project needs to update the guardrail to current standards which would involve removing and resetting the guardrail to the 2'-1" required height and to have the TL-3 anchor units installed on the ends.
- 5. Label radius proposed on sidewalk meander around poles/guy wires....would recommend this be smoother (at least 20' reverse curve).
- 6. Show a curb and gutter flare detail; recommend 20' radius taking face of curb at least 2' back further away from EOP; then tapering asphalt pavement at a 10:1 to this point. (If you need a sketch let me know).
- 7. Show/label any "wet utility" adjustments to be performed (i.e. valve adjustments, manhole adjustments, FH relocates, etc.) on the plans for the Contractor to perform with appropriate CFPUA details).
- 8. Show/label any "dry utility" conflicts/adjustments and label who you need to coordinate those conflicts with. These need to be coordinated ahead of construction (i.e. guy wires, poles, utility handholes, gas valves, pedestals, etc.).
  - Please note that Duke Energy has recently installed some new poles and guy wires along roadway; Engineer will need to review any additional conflicts with these.
- 9. Existing there are three (3) front/back Chevron signs (MUTCD W1-8); See MUTCD section 2C.10 for Chevron Alignment and proper installation height/size.
- 10. Please note on plans that in the area where you are not building sidewalk (Sta 7+00 to 9+00 +/-LT) shoulder (12' wide with 3:1 slopes) still needs to be constructed and seeded.

11. Please See Pavement Marking comments and sketch; NCDOT has been going with 90 mils now on most markings; Recommend showing signs on pavement marking plans; Show retain or

relocate for ALL signs within work area. Coordinate with Randall Glazier, Signs & Markings Engineer (#341-0069, Randall.Glazier@wilmingtonnc.gov).



### MARSHES AT RIVER'S EDGE PHASES 3, 4, 5 [Other Version Review #2]

### **TECHNICAL STANDARDS:**

• The City's 20'x70' sight distance triangle at the driveway is not shown correctly. Refer below image and revise. [Sec.18-529(c) (3) CofW LDC] [Sec. 18-812 CofW LDC]. Add a note indicating that all proposed vegetation within sight triangles shall not interfere with clear visual sight lines from 30"-10'. [Sec.18-556 CofW LDC]



• SIGHT DISTANCE TRIANGLE FOR ANY STREET/DRIVEWAY INTERSECTIONS WITH THOROUGHFARES River Rd is a major thoroughfare [Chap VII (C) (2) (a) of CofW Tech Stds]. In accordance with the City Code, sight distances along thoroughfares must be calculated in compliance with the AASHTO requirements. [Chap VII (C) (1) of CofW Tech Stds] [Sec.18-556 CofW LDC]. Show AASHTO in addition to 20'x70' SDT.

This was not commented on in review but will also be required from the driveway permit point of view.
