Site Plan Comments:

- Sec. 18-60 (c) (5): Additional information in the site data table as follows:
 - Update proposed building setbacks. Setbacks on the site plan do not match the site data table. For example, the rear setback proposed is 37.5 feet, not 25 ft.
- Sec. 18-60 (c) (11): Show location and dimension of all fencing and screening, including existing chain link fence. What is the height of the fence?
- Sec. 18-60 (c) (15): Show a proposed landscape plan. **Repeat comment.**
- Sec. 18-60 (c) (16): Please include a sheet with both the site plan and the tree removal overlaid for verification of proposed tree removal and required tree mitigation or exemptions. Thank you for the sheet. I agree with the tree removal within the building footprint. Need labels on trees removed within the new parking area to confirm mitigation calculations.
- Sec. 18-60 (c) (17): Add five proposed bike spaces to the site data table.

Landscape Plan to Include:

- Trees per disturbed acre
- Streetyard
- Interior landscaping
- Bufferyard
- Foundation plantings for addition
- Sec. 18-462 (d) (9): Show adjacent zoning district including across the street or streets.
- Sec. 18-462 (d) (10): Show approximate locations of all trees greater than eight (8) inch DBH within the required buffers and of all natural vegetation to be used part of the buffer.
- Sec. 18-462 (d) (11): Show setbacks of all structures and specifications and shielding of certain uses as required.
- Sec. 18-462 (d) (12): Show locations of any Conservation Resources associated with the parcel including any Rare and Endangered species in accordance with the North Carolina Wildlife Resource Commission.
